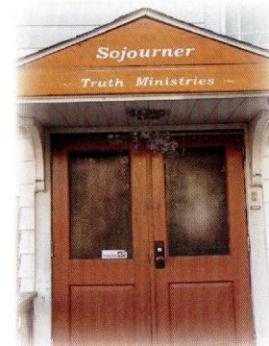

SOJOURNER TRUTH 1797-1883

Sojourner Truth was born a slave known as Isabella Baumfree in 1797. She was a slave in New York and Pennsylvania. She was freed in 1822 by the Pennsylvania Legislature. Upon receiving her freedom, she became a Methodist preacher and changed her name to Sojourner Truth. She preached against slavery and for Women's Rights. She met with and advised Presidents Lincoln and Grant. She died in 1883.
